Reporting to the Production Manager/Technical Director, responsibilities will include, but not be limited to:

- Research historical backgrounds and detail of prop designs as required
- Construct or procure (purchase/borrow/rent) all props as required, under the guidance and approval of the set designer and PM, and within budgetary limits
- Prepare rehearsal props as required
- Maintain a clean, safe and secure working environment, including performing minor repairs to theatre equipment and tools
- Organize and maintain props storage areas. Monitor stock and inform PM of required materials
- Maintain props during the run of shows where possible
- Work, when necessary and feasible, on other theatre or production projects

COMPENSATION: \$480/week

This position is suitable for an emerging props designer or student.

Work hours vary based on production needs and schedule requirements. Flexibility is recommended.
